India proud once again

he Haryana girl Manushi Chillar won the coveted beauty title 17 years after Priyanka Chopra putting India on the global map once again. She became the sixth women from India to have won the crown. Other women from India who brought the Miss World crown home include Reita Faria (1996), Aishwarya Rain Bachchan (1994), Diana Haydon (1997), Yukta Mookhey (1999) and Priyanka Chopra (2000).

Before being crowned the Miss World, Chillar was studying medicine at the Bhagat Phool Singh Government Medical College for Women in Sonepat. She has completed her schooling from St. Thomas School in New Delhi. Her father is a doctor her mother is an academic working with the Institute of Human Behaviour and Allied Sciences.

Now that Manushi Chillar has already won the Miss World title she wants to pursue her medical studies and wants to become a cardio surgeon in future.

Manushi is also a trained Kuchipudi dancer besides being associated with a project for menstrual hygiene among women.

In December last year, Manushi Chillar won the Miss Campus Princess title in college while pursuing her MBBS course..

After that she bagged the 'Miss Haryana' title in April 2017 followed by the prestigious Femina Miss India title in June this year. She also won the Beauty with Purpose award for spreading awareness about menstrual hygiene among girls and women through her 'Project Shakti' campaign. As part of her campaign she visited 20 villages and treated over 5,000 women.

Having accomplished so much at such a young age, she went on to become Miss World 2017 defeating 118 contestants from different countries. She was crowned on 18 November 2017 by Stephanie Del Valle from Puerto Rico in Sanya, China. Stephanie was crowned Miss World in 2016.

Later she also attended the 2017 Global Entrepreneurship Summit held in Hyderabad as one of the speakers. She was also announced as the brand ambassador for Anaemia Free Haryana. Her campaign 'Project Shakti' has also received a government support of 18 crore by Haryana Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar to make sure the free availability of sanitary napkins across all government schools in Haryana. Manushi Chillar was also honoured with the Special Achievement Award at the 2017 CNN-IBN Indian of the Year Awards for making India proud by winning the Miss World 2017 title.
















BOLLYWOOD ON SCREEN DIOES GIVING US MAJOR BRIDE GOALS








KEEP A TOUCHUP KIT HANDY
