



#### India's First Miss Trans Queen

The visibility of transgender has considerably increased during the recent time. In July 2014, transgenders were recognized as third gender by the Supreme Court of India and this year India held the first ever beauty pageant for transgender. 26 year old Nitasha Biswas hailing from Kolkata bagged the Miss Trans Queen 2017 title thereby becoming the first one from the community to represent India at different platforms available for the community. The first runner up position was taken up by Loiloi from Manipur whereas the Ragasya, who hails from Chennai, got the second position.

Nitasha is still pursuing her Masters in Business Management and is all set to represent India at the International Queen pageant in Thailand to be held in March 2018 whereas the first runner up is expected to compete at Miss Transexual Australia. This will not only enhance the profile of India's trans gender community but will also help in their visibility and acceptance across the country.

Reena Rai, a former business woman and the founder cum chairperson of Suhani Dream Catchers Pvt Ltd, happens to be the brain behind the whole concept. She left her job to devote herself wholeheartedly to the cause of the transgender community. She believed that change will only come when straight people stand up for them. A judge panel consisting of 11-person presided over the event which included transgender social activist Gauri Sawant as well as Mr Gay India Sushant Divgikar.

Although there is has been wider acceptance of third gender in India and across the world, they still have to go through much discrimination and fight for their rights. Their fight and struggle for acceptance and is very much real and most of us don't understand this. Their fight starts at an early age when their own family refuses to accept them. Most of them are not lucky to get education and basic facilities and end up on the streets. The event saw more than 1500 trans women from different parts of India. Most of them have experienced social exclusion in one form or another due to their gender identity. However, with more events like this the transgender community will surely find acceptance and empowerment.




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# For the lady in red
